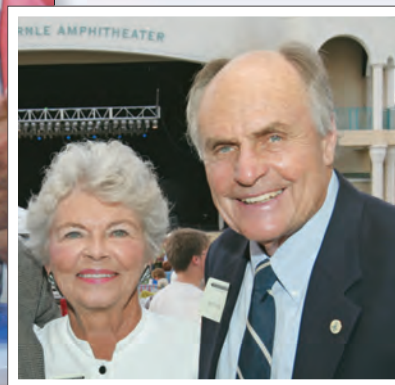
UNIVERSITY SALUTES HEROES
